Jakeman's is a working maple syrup farm tapping approximately 1,000 taps. We use plastic line with a few buckets. We make maple sugar, maple butter and granulated maple sugar. For the rest of the year we sell maple products wholesale in the high end gift and souvenir shops, Duty-free stores and export maple syrup around the World.

Take a self guided walking tour in our Woodlot where you can see the actual sap lines, learn how the sap is collected from the tree and then to the evaporator. At the same time you can learn how to identify trees with their bark, wildlife and their habitat as well as make a living from the woodlot.

From there, visit the Sugar Shanty where you will see the evaporating/finishing process. (although due to Health and Safety, you cannot actually go into the Shanty).

It's back into the warmth where you will be able to sit down, watch a video, someone can be on hand to answer your questions. View our private museum of farm and household implements used by the generations of the Jakeman family.
